Featured will be four special cars that have each been honored with an invitation to participate in a prestigious concours this past year. The four featured concours cars are the 1946 Hewson Rocket (winner of the Class – 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Ubiquitous Ford Flat-Head V8 at 2007 Goodwood Festival of Speed); 1938 Citroën Berline Gazogene; 1932 Helicron (winner of the “People’s Choice Award” at Ault Park Concours d’Elegance – June, 2007); and the 1936 Panhard Dynamic X76.

Lane Motor Museum showcases approximately 150 unique cars and motorcycles from around the world. Cars on display represent countries from Asia, Europe, and North and South America, and date from 1924 to 2003. Highlights of the Museum include the largest Czechoslovakian vehicle collection outside Europe, microcars, amphibious vehicles, alternative fuel vehicles, competition cars, motorcycles, military vehicles, and prototypes. The Museum also offers a display of automotive art, a special play area for children, and a gift shop.
