Family Day at Lane Motor Museum

Friday, July 14, 2006

Activities begin at 11:00 a.m.

Nashville TN, June 27, 2006. Bring the family to Lane Motor Museum and experience a day "geared" towards kids! Event will be held on Friday, July 14, 2006, and will begin at 11 a.m. with car crafts followed by children's tours, coloring contests, car demonstrations, and one scheduled vehicle ride for kids. A complete schedule is below. All activities will take place at the Museum.

Three children's tours are planned and will focus on amphibious vehicles, a car that can run on gas or be pedaled, and the largest Museum vehicle called the LARC. Two vehicles will also be demonstrated at the Museum, and kids can take a *ride in a 1966 Fiat Nuova 500 (same type of car as "Luigi" in the movie *Cars*).

***Rides in the 1966 Fiat 500 will take place at 2:00 p.m. and are on a first come, first served basis, weather permitting. Rides will take place on Museum grounds.**

Event activities start times (all times are approximate):

11:00 to 3:00 p.m. – Ongoing car crafts in the children's play area

-11:00 a.m. – Children's tour

-11:30 a.m. – Coloring Contest I – children's play area

-12:30 p.m. – Demonstrate a 1965 Peel P50 – the smallest street legal car

- 1:00 p.m. – Demonstrate a 1974 Faun Kraka – a military vehicle that folds in half

- 2:00 p.m. – Rides in a 1966 Fiat Nuova 500 – same type of car as "Luigi" in the movie *Cars*.

- 2:30 p.m. – Children's tour

- 3:00 p.m. – Coloring Contest II – children's play area

- 3:30 p.m. – Children's tour

About Lane Motor Museum

Lane Motor Museum showcases approximately 150 unique cars and motorcycles from around the world. Cars on display represent countries from Asia, Europe, and North and South America, and date from 1922 to 2003. Highlights of the Museum include the largest Czechoslovakian vehicle collection outside Europe, microcars, amphibious vehicles, alternative fuel vehicles, competition cars, motorcycles, military vehicles, and prototypes. The Museum also offers a display of automotive art, a special play area for children, and a gift shop.

Lane Motor Museum welcomes guests Thursday through Monday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Closed: Tuesday & Wednesday; Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day & New Year's Day. Regular admission is \$5 for adults, \$3 for seniors (55+), and free for children 17 and under. Group rates are available.
